Tower Gardens is a cul-de-sac development at the top of Deep Lane and is a collection of flats, houses and bungalows, many of which enjoy views back over the town and all within walking distance of the town's amenities.











The entrance hall with understairs cupboard and plenty of room for coat and shoe storage, leads through into the spacious open plan living space. There is a large picture window at the front, then from the dining area there is patio doors leading to the garden. The kitchen in a u-shaped format has plenty of modern cupboards, includes an oven and induction hob and space for washing machine, fridge/freezer, etc. The flooring is an attractive light-oak vinyl.

Upstairs there are two good sized double bedrooms and lovely views over the town to the open countryside. The bathroom has a white suite L-shape bath with shower over and a glass screen.

Outside there is a garden to the front laid to decorative chippings for ease of maintenance and at the back, the rear enclosed garden (6.7m x 4.7m) is partly paved and partly decorative chippings. There is a rear access gate to a lane behind the row of terraces. The garage is found in a block above the row of terraces and has an up and over door. Plenty of parking can be found on-street in the cul-de-sac.










Ground Floor
