Location:

Ramsey Mereside is located approximately three miles from Ramsey which is a major town. This is a rural village with a takeaway, village hall, and a motorbike parts shop.

Local Attractions:

Fenland Light Railway: A 7¼" gauge miniature railway located within the village.

Ramsey Heights Nature Reserve: A small reserve featuring ponds formed from abandoned clay pits, rich in aquatic plants and insect life. Managed by the Wildlife Trust.

Ramsey Rural Museum: Situated in 17th-century farm buildings, this museum is dedicated to the history of rural Fenland life, showcasing artifacts and exhibits that reflect the local heritage.

Rail:

The nearest train station is Whittlesea Station, approximately 4.4 miles away. Other nearby stations include Peterborough March, Huntingdon and Manea.

Bus:

Route 31: Operated by Stagecoach East, this route connects Peterborough and Ramsey. Key stops include Whittlesey Bus Interchange, Kings Delph, and Ramsey.

Route RH5: Part of the Rural Hopper services provided by Ramsey Community Bus, RH5 operates every Friday. It starts at Upwood, passes through Ramsey's villages—including Ramsey Mereside—and proceeds to the Ramsey shopping centre and Tesco store.

Road:

B1096 → Links Ramsey Mereside to Ramsey and the surrounding villages.

A141 → The nearest major road, connecting to Huntingdon and March.

A1(M) & A47 → For access to Peterborough and further afield.
