An absolutely stunning 2 bedroom semidetached house which has been the subject of almost complete refurbishment and enlargement by the owner in recent years to create a beautiful home with an extended kitchen/living area with vaulted ceiling, glass gable and bi-folding doors out to a 75' rear garden, situated in a quiet cul-de-sac on the southern edge of town close to the hospital, St Wilfrid's primary school, town centre and within a 1.2 mile walk of the railway station.

The property is located in a cul-de-sac in this established part of town just to the south/east of the town centre between the main shopping areas and the hospital, with a regular bus service running from Franklynn Road linking the station and neighbouring districts. Local facilities include a Coop store and late night petrol station and within a 5/10 minute walk you have the main shopping areas of South Road, the Princess Royal Hospital, Birch Hotel and St Wilfrid's Primary School. Children from this side of town fall into the catchment area for Oathall Community college in neighbouring Lindfield with its farm (1.3 miles). The town has an extensive range of shops, stores, cafes, restaurants and bars in The Broadway. There are numerous leisure groups, sports clubs and a state of the art leisure centre. The railway station provides fast commuter links to London (Victoria/London Bridge 45 mins), Gatwick Airport 15 mins and Brighton 20 mins). Adjoining the station is a Waitrose Store with a cafe and there is a Sainsbury's Superstore just a little further on under the railway bridge.

By road, access to the major surrounding areas can be gained via the B 2272 and the A/M23, the latter lying about 6 miles to the west at Bolney.


