Marylands is a short cul-de-sac situated off New England Road on the town's rejuvenated eastern side within a short walk of local shops, schools and the town centre. The railway station is within a 1 mile walk.

There are several primary schools within walking distance and children from the side of town generally fall into the catchment area for Oathall School in neighbouring Lindfield, which is within a 15 minute walk.

The village of Lindfield with its picturesque Village High Street is easily accessed on foot via the Scrase Valley Nature reserve where there is a duckpond and large common which hosts several events throughout the year.

Haywards Heath town centre is just over half a mile where there is an extensive range of shops, restaurants, cafés and bars. The town also has a 6th form college and a leisure Centre.


