

Garaging is exceptional, with space for around eight vehicles in the main house and detached barns that can accommodate up to 25 cars in total. This remarkable estate seamlessly fuses historic grandeur with modern luxury and is a truly rare opportunity to own a piece of paradise in Jersey's peaceful countryside.

Additionally, the estate benefits from a borehole supply dedicated to irrigation, which supports watering of the extensive gardens and surrounding fields, helping maintain the beautifully landscaped grounds sustainably. This combination of services underlines the property's blend of practical infrastructure and luxury living in a rural Jersey setting.

Parking

Le Grand Mourier boasts a unique car lift within its extensive garage facilities, which allows vehicles to be moved effortlessly from a showroom-style garage to an upper-level garage. This feature enables the display and secure storage of prized cars across multiple levels, enhancing both functionality and luxury for car collectors. Alongside the lift, there is parking for approximately eight vehicles inside the main house and additional capacity for around 25 cars across detached barns on the estate. This sophisticated setup ensures ample, secure, and convenient parking for a large collection of vehicles







Land

Le Grand Mourier sits on approximately 6.13 acres of land, providing extensive grounds that include beautifully landscaped gardens, woodland paths, fields, and a natural pool area. This generous land size enhances the property's privacy, outdoor living potential, and overall appeal as a luxurious rural estate in Jersey. Fields J126 and J132 associated with Le Grand Mourier are designated as equine fields, indicating they are suitable and likely used for horse grazing or related equestrian purposes. This adds significant value for equestrian enthusiasts or anyone seeking land equipped for horse keeping within the estate's extensive grounds.


































