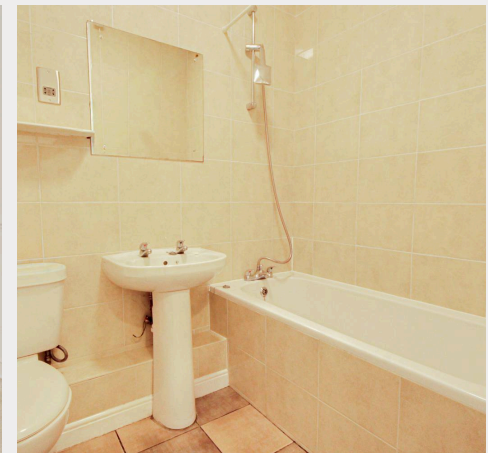


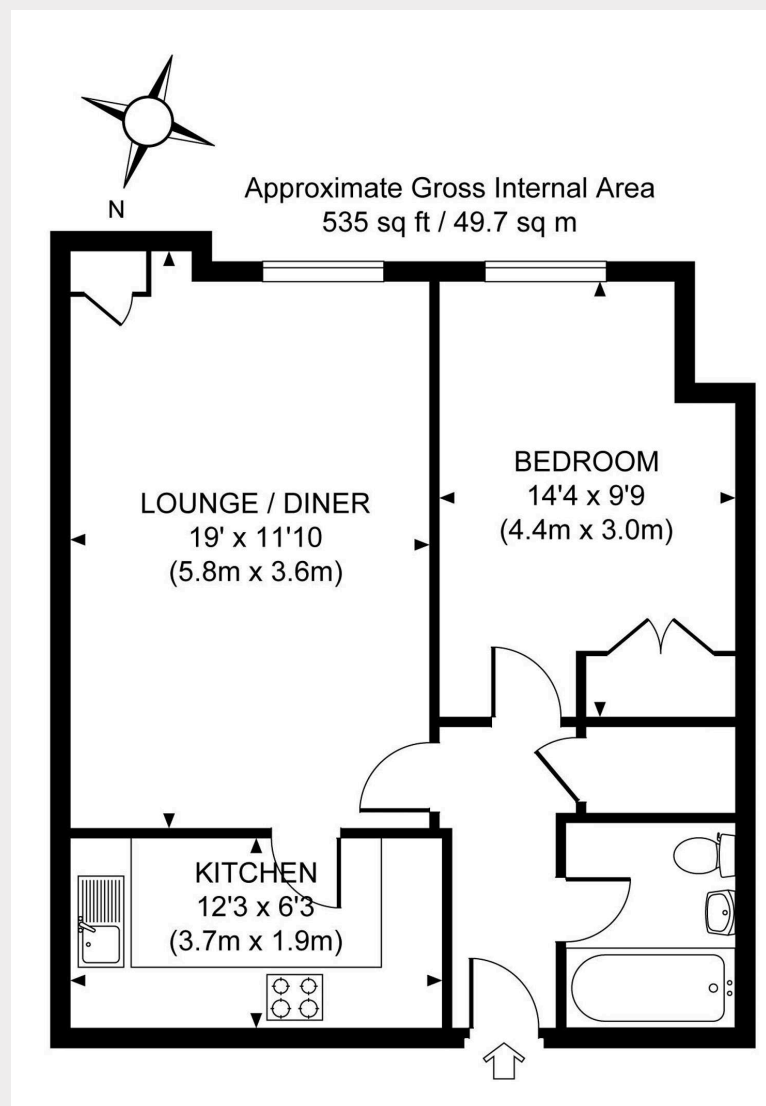
Southdowns Park is situated off Colwell Road on the southern side of town within easy reach of the A272 relief road and close to the Princess Royal Hospital.

There is a Coop and Sainsbury's local supermarket within a 10 minute walk providing most daily needs. A bus service runs along Colwell Road linking with the town centre's extensive range of shops and mainline railway station which offers a fast and regular service to London (Victoria/London Bridge 47 mins), Gatwick Airport (15 mins) and the south east (Brighton 20 mins).

The town also has a broad range of sports and leisure facilities including a leisure centre and several restaurants, cafes and bars in The Broadway. There is a nursery school in the adjacent old Chapel and the town has several schools and a 6th form college.

By road, access to the major surrounding areas can be gained via the A272, the B2112 and the A/M23, the latter lying approximately 6 miles to the west at Bolney or Warminglid.
