Four Oaks, Chichester

An individual Arts and Crafts house of distinction with excellent scope to further improve, standing in 1.13 acre garden

Centrally positioned within a mature plot extending to 1.13 acres, this individually designed Arts and Crafts residence is steeped in charm and character.

The property is believed to date from the period between the wars and is built in a distinctive Tudor style, featuring oak beams, thumb latch doors, leaded light windows and Tudor style fireplaces.

Since purchasing the property in 2003, the present owners have extended the living accommodation into the original garage to create a spacious dual aspect dining room with bi-folding doors opening to the garden.









The property also has a large drawing room with an open fireplace, a large bay window and French doors open to a south facing veranda. There is also a second sitting room and study/fifth bedroom.

The kitchen is the hub of the home with classic shaker style cupboards, integrated appliances, granite worktops and breakfast bar. A cloakroom and utility room complete the ground floor. Upstairs, there are four bedrooms and a family bathroom. The principal bedroom has an en-suite shower room.

Outside, the secluded gardens are enveloped by mature trees and hedges. Double wrought iron gates open to a private drive and extensive parking area. The drive leads to a triple garaging block comprising a single and double garage. The garden is predominantly laid to lawn and has an alfresco dining area outside the dining room.

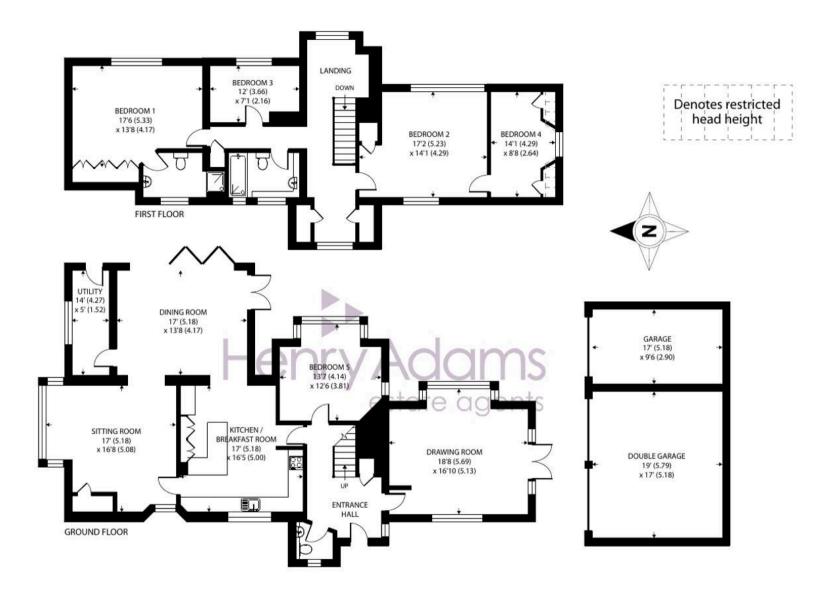

Location - The house is situated in a semi-rural location on the edge of the cathedral city of Chichester which offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars, Festival Theatre and a mainline station to London Victoria. Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are excellent sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.
