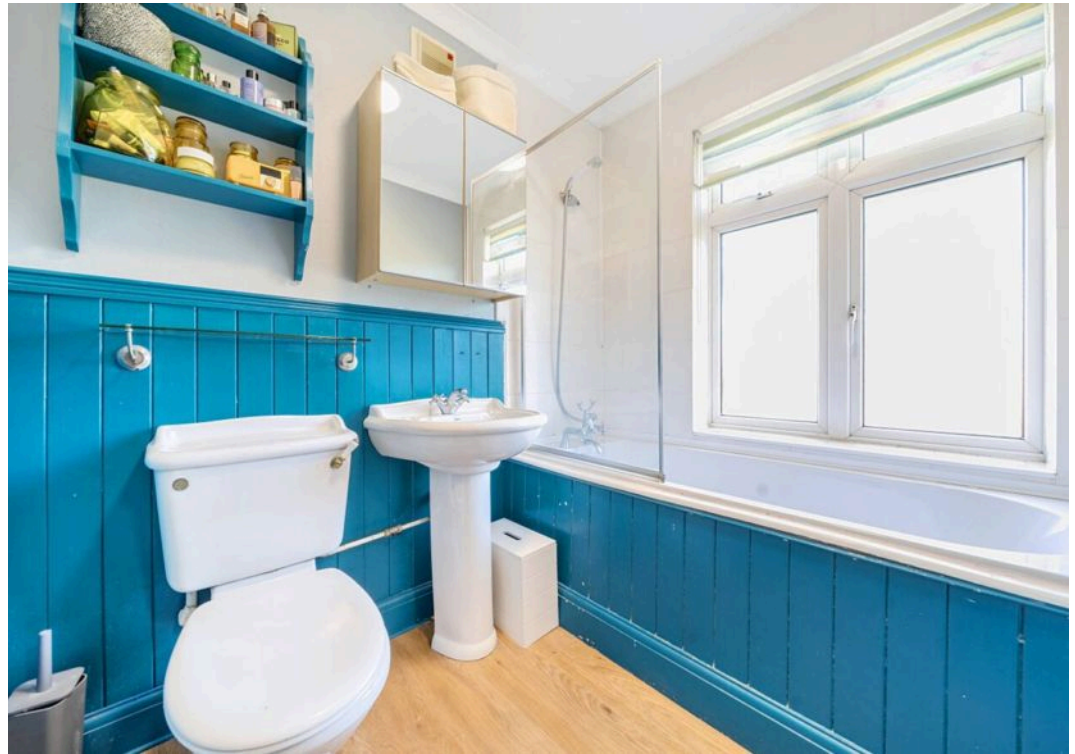

A traditional 1930s detached family house, full of character and retaining many original features including picture rails, internal doors and fireplaces. Situated in a convenient, non-estate location on the desirable south side of the city, the property offers easy access to the train station, local shops, schools and the A27.

The accommodation comprises an entrance hall with cloakroom, a cosy sitting room featuring a bay window, a kitchen fitted with pine units and an integrated gas oven and hob. To the rear, a sunny extended family/dining room with a wood burner and bi-folding doors opens onto the attractive garden. Upstairs are three bedrooms and a family bathroom.

Outside, the secluded front garden is beautifully stocked with mature shrubs. A driveway and turning area provide ample parking, with the drive extending along the side of the house to a small single garage. The mature rear garden features an extensive lawn and well-planted borders, offering a peaceful and private outdoor space.

Location - There is a parade of shops nearby, including a butcher, a hairdresser, bicycle shop and a launderette, as well as a Co-op convenience store. The property is approximately half a mile south of the leisure complex/restaurants/cinema, the canal and Chichester's train station with services to London (Victoria) and along the coast. The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars and the Festival Theatre. Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing including the Qatar Goodwood Festival. There are superb sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.
