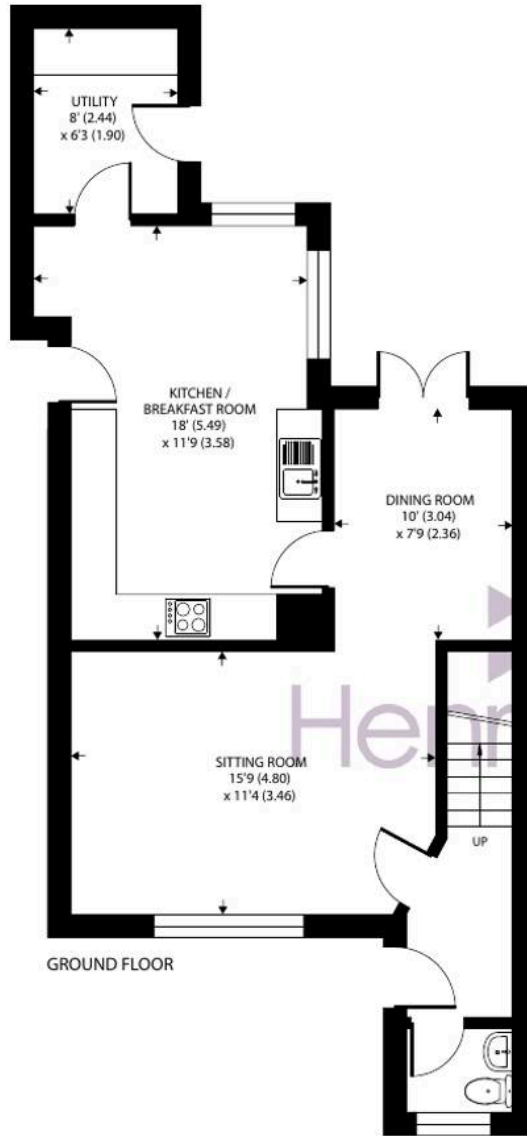
A tastefully extended three-bedroom mid-terraced home, ideally situated at the end of a quiet cul-de-sac in a highly sought-after village setting, approximately three miles east of Chichester. Positioned on the doorstep of the renowned Goodwood Estate and the stunning South Downs National Park, this property offers an excellent balance of countryside living and convenient access to local amenities.

The accommodation comprises an entrance hall, cloakroom, comfortable sitting room and an extended kitchen/dining room. The kitchen is fitted with an attractive range of grey shaker-style wall and base units, with space for a range-style cooker and plumbing for an American-style fridge freezer. The dining area enjoys French doors opening onto a courtyard-style rear garden featuring decking and patio areas, ideal for outdoor entertaining. A door from the kitchen leads to a practical utility/boot room. On the first floor there are three bedrooms. Bedroom one benefits from built-in wall-to-wall wardrobes with integrated drawers. The family bathroom is fitted with an electric shower over the bath.

Externally, the front garden is enclosed by a low wall, while roadside parking is available within the cul-de-sac.

Location - Within the village there is a village hall, village shop, church, primary school and easy access to the A27. Nearby there is a pub/restaurant in Halnaker and Tinwood Estate Vineyard offering tours and wine tasting, lodges and private dining. Further local facilities can be found in Tangmere. Goodwood is famous for its many event days including the world renowned Festival of Speed and Goodwood Revival for motor racing enthusiasts and a season of horse racing. The cathedral city of Chichester offers excellent high street shopping, many fashionable restaurants, cafes and bars, festival theatre and a mainline station to London Victoria. There are excellent sailing facilities around Chichester Harbour and water sports from the beaches at West Wittering. The area is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts, with beautiful walks and cycle tracks over the South Downs and around the harbour.

Directions - Proceed east out of Chichester and then along the A27 in an easterly direction. On reaching the Boxgrove/Tangmere roundabout take the first exit signposted to Boxgrove (The Street). Proceed round the bend and after a short distance, at the mini-roundabout, turn left into Crouch Cross Lane. Take the first right into Kirkby Close and at the end number 7 is in the cul-de-sac on the right. What3words - bungalows.subjects.souk
